





FAQ - Young Crew Finland

Q: How much time I need to commit in different roles?

A: Board roles are requiring 1-2 days per month throughout the year 2025. Project Manager role depending on the project: we have small to large projects, taking up to (few hours) to 10-12 days during the duration of the project, which can be from 1 month to 6 months. We can help you plan and manage your time, if you want.

Q: If I apply to be a PM, can I decide what project I want to do?

A: Yes, we are a volunteer network, so you can choose (or come up with an idea for) a project you want to do and one that will help you reach your goals

Q: How much travelling is required?

A: All travelling is voluntary. We do have face to face event and team building meetings, but participation is always voluntary. In a board role team building is more expected. If you apply to be a PM in a project that includes organising a face-to-face event, then you should be ready to travel

Q: Are all the roles interacting with companies and institutions?

A: You are allowed to contact these in all roles. Some roles specifically include interactions with these (like B2B relations manager and International relations manager), as well as projects where you contact schools and sponsors, like the PMC project.

Q: Is PMC only for students?

A: Yes, for University and University of Applied sciences students living in Finland. We do have competitions like GeCCo, that is for students and other young people between the ages 18-35.

Q: Do I receive any training, if I want to be a PM?

A: Team will always help you and the team leader can assist by coaching and mentoring. We also have access to training materials and recording that are really helpful. We can also organise trainings ourselves (we also have a role Competence development manager that focuses on the training and learning needs of the team and the network �\(\dot\)) We also try to find you a project that will challenge you a little bit but be not too difficult. You won't be left alone as PM and there's always help and support available \(\dot\)

Q: How about the language?

A: We have both English speaking and Finnish speaking people in the team. This is also great opportunity to practice your professional English or to train your Finnish skills •
